

2009 IOWA STATE FAIR FFA NOMINATION AND ENTRY PROCESS

To be eligible to participate at the Iowa State Fair, members must follow these procedures:

1. Mail tag/tattoo order forms to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department on or before the due date.
2. Submit nominations using the FFA Online System (www.iowastatefair.org/entry) on or before the due date. (Nominations do not need to be submitted for: Ag Mechanics & Technology, Floriculture, Horticulture, Photography, Poultry and Rabbits.)
3. Mail the DNA samples and nose prints (Performance Beef) to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department on or before the due date. Payment for each DNA sample **must** be included with a check made payable to the Iowa State Fair.
4. Submit entries using the FFA Online System (www.iowastatefair.org/entry) on or before July 1.
5. Mail the Chapter Summary Report, Code of Ethics sheet for each exhibitor and payment of fees to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department on or before July 1.

NO LATE NOMINATIONS / ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED REGARDLESS OF THE REASON.

Derby pig tattoo order forms are to be sent to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department. The tattoo must be returned by the noted due date or all derby pigs from the delinquent chapter will not be eligible to show at the Iowa State Fair.

Sheep and swine tag order forms are to be sent to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department. The unused tags must be returned by the noted due date or all market/carcass lambs, all commercial ewes and ewe lambs and all derby pigs, market pigs and commercial gilts from the delinquent chapter will not be eligible to show at the Iowa State Fair.

Swine tags and tattoos, lamb tags and all needed equipment for collecting hair samples will be available for FFA advisors to pick up at the State FFA Leadership Conference in April. FFA advisors not able to pick up these materials at this time need to contact the Iowa State Fair to make other arrangements.

An FFA advisor and one other adult must be present to witness the nomination of all performance beef, market pigs, derby pigs, commercial gilts, market lambs and commercial ewes.

UNDER ABSOLUTELY NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD EXHIBITORS BE ALLOWED TO TAKE HOME TAGS OR DNA SAMPLE ENVELOPES AND DO THE WORK THEMSELVES WITHOUT THE SUPERVISION OF AN FFA ADVISOR AND ANOTHER WITNESS.

All nominations **must be submitted online** on or before the deadline.
Paper copies **will not** be accepted.

MEMBERS MUST BE LISTED ON YOUR CHAPTER'S ROSTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN ORDER TO BE INCLUDED ON THE FFA ONLINE SYSTEM.

REMINDER: DNA samples, nose print cards (Performance Beef) and payment must be sent to the Iowa State Fair FFA Entry Department on or before the nomination deadline. The Chapter Summary Report, Code of Ethics sheet for each exhibitor and payment of fees must be sent to the Iowa State Fair FFA Department on or before July 1.

FFA All Species Identification/Nomination Sheet

Cost

The cost of nominating Performance Beef, Market/Carcass Lambs, Commercial Ewes, Commercial Gilts, Derby Pigs and Market Pigs is \$4.00 per animal. The payment, made payable to the Iowa State Fair, must be remitted with the DNA paperwork for timely processing of nominations.

Dates

Please enclose all DNA materials, nose print cards (Performance Beef) and payment per the species specific nomination date. Nominations must be submitted online on or before the species specific nomination date.

February 1st - Performance Beef

April 28th - Derby Pigs

May 15th - Market Pigs, Commercial Gilts, Market/Carcass Lambs and Commercial Ewes

Nomination Process

Obtain all necessary signatures needed for nose prints (Performance Beef) and DNA samples. If a parent or the exhibitor is not present, they will need to obtain signature waiver forms from their FFA advisor.

The exhibitor's FFA advisor and one other adult must witness and supervise the weighing, tagging and collection of hair samples for all market pigs, commercial gilts and derby pigs. Nomination of FFA lambs must be witnessed by an FFA advisor and another adult or be completed during a county lamb weigh-in.

All extra tags, DNA envelopes and all necessary equipment MUST be returned to the Iowa State Fair by May 15, or the delinquent chapter may not be eligible to show at the 2009 Iowa State Fair.

General Swine Rules

1. Pigs must be ear notched using the national ear notching system (1-3-9-27-81). The pig's right ear is the litter number and the pig's left ear is the pig number.
2. Hair samples must be taken from each pig nominated. 20-40 hairs must be pulled from each pig, using pliers. Do not cut the hair with a knife or scissors. Place hair samples in the appropriate Iowa State Fair envelopes; make sure the envelope is completed thoroughly with all necessary signatures.

Derby Pigs

1. Barrows and gilts may both be nominated with the maximum number being 15. Four of those may be entered in the derby show at the Fair. Weigh-in date is April 25th.
2. The maximum nomination weight shall be 45 pounds.
3. Every pig nominated must have the FFA issued special tattoo placed on the backside of one of its ears, between the 1 and 3 ear notch location. It is recommended that green tattoo ink be used. Please make sure the tattoo is cleaned before returning; return the tattoo in the container it was sent in. If a chapter does not return the tattoo by the deadline, all derby pigs from that chapter will not be eligible to show at the Iowa State Fair.
3. **Derby pigs will also automatically be nominated as market pigs/commercial gilts.**
4. Derby pigs must be identified by all of the following methods:
 - a. Ear Notches
 - b. FFA Issued Ear Tag
 - c. FFA Issued Special Design Tattoo
 - d. Color of Pig
 - e. Sex of Pig
 - f. Hair samples to be used for DNA testing

Market Pigs and Commercial Gilts

1. Each exhibitor is only allowed to nominate a maximum of 40 market pigs/commercial gilts and show a maximum of 4 crossbred and 4 registered market pigs and 2 commercial gilts at the Fair. Market pigs can be either barrows or gilts.
2. Market pigs and commercial gilts must be identified by all of the following methods:
 - a. Ear Notches
 - b. FFA Issued Ear Tag
 - c. Color of Pig
 - d. Sex of Pig
 - e. Hair Samples to be used for DNA testing

Market/Carcass Lambs and Commercial Ewes

1. Market/carcass lambs and commercial ewes need to be identified by the following methods:
 - a. FFA Supplied Ear Tag
 - b. Hair Sample to be used for DNA testing
 - c. Sex
 - d. Birth date

NOTE: Nose prints are not required.
